Launches a menu listing program shortcuts with your favorite hotkey.



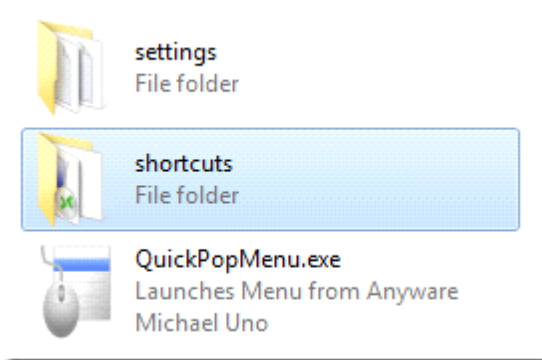

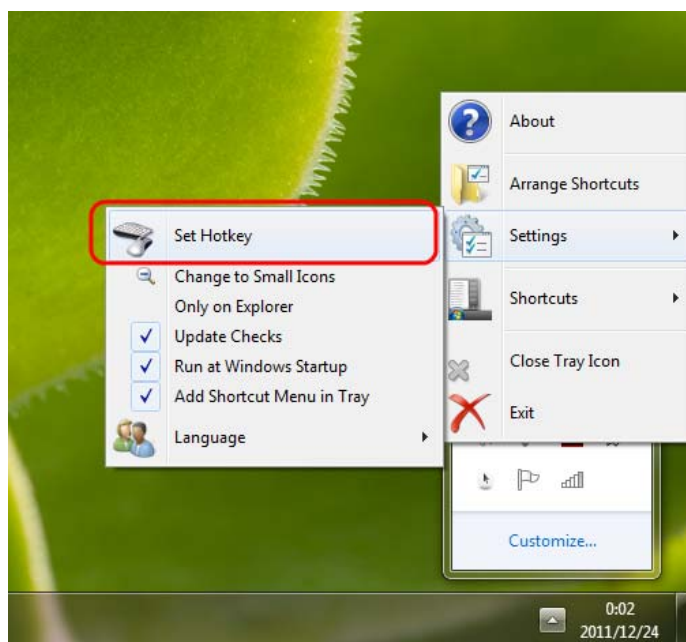
Usage

Get Started

Double click and run QuickPopMenu.exe. It will create a folder, "shortcuts."



Drop your shortcut files in it and they will be shown in the menu. You can place folders and subfolders as well. Call the menu with Control + Middle click by default. It can be changed via **Tray icon -> Settings -> Set Hotkey**.



Calling the menu via Command-Line

Specify the path of a shortcut folder as parameter. e.g. *QuickPopMenu.exe "D:\App\Quick Menu \shortcutsB"*. When this method is used, the program exits right after the menu is called.

Remarks

It is recommended for 32-bit environment users to use the file in the *32bit* folder and for 64-bit environment to use the file in the *64bit* folder. This program is portable so no installation is required.
